Sequencing

The purpose of Year 11 is to revisit all literature texts. However, we moved AIC from Autumn as we felt it important to teach language on their return after lockdown to revisit key skills. New: in light of changes to Lit, we have removed AIC and built in more time to revise poetry as taught in lockdown period and revise key skills required for language as well. 2 week isolation of Yr 11 in Sept meant we changed from teaching both PPr 1 and 2 to just PPr 2, building in more time later in the year for PPr 1, unfortunately at the expense of literature.

In Year 11 only Ppr 1 of the two language papers will have already been taught explicitly. Ppr 2 was 'taught' in lockdown alongside some poetry. Learning builds upon the skills taught throughout Year 10.

The only new text is 'An Inspector Calls', saved for Yr 11 for the reasons outlined in the Yr 10 PoS. NEW - removed as of Sept 2020
