

## COVID Recovery Plan - Maths - 2021-22

Curriculum adjustments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Year 7 assessment and SOW adjustments, taking into consideration NCETM guidance - as follows:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Wb 18th Oct - students streamed based on CAT4 QR scores</li><li>○ 'Ready to progress' assessment for most students in year 7</li><li>○ 'Calculations and Number' assessment for EAL students</li><li>○ Wb 1st Nov - 7x3 and 7y3 to follow transition scheme of work</li><li>○ Other groups to follow core scheme of work (expressions and formulae)</li><li>○ Wb 22nd Nov - All groups complete 3 weeks intervention using 'ready-to-progress' assessment to inform planning.</li></ul></li><li>● Removal of selected outcomes, across all year groups, to allow focus on core content</li><li>● Aiming for Grade 4 scheme of work introduced in year 10 and year 11</li><li>● Specific intervention weeks removed from year 10 to allow for more time and flexibility</li><li>● Entry for EDEXCEL Award in Number and Measure - post 16</li></ul>
Teaching and learning adjustments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Bell activities to review key skills (focussing on missed content)</li><li>● High quality AfL (to pinpoint gaps in prior knowledge)</li><li>● Flexibility for teachers to tweak scheme of work according to their groups</li><li>● Use of catch up funding to purchase paper based assessments for year 11 (lack of exposure last year)</li></ul>
Additional interventions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Summer school for years 10 into 11 and 12 into 13</li><li>● Year 7 early communication with parents - letter sent Sept 2021</li><li>● SNo - lunchtime support in learning base</li><li>● Year 7 and 11 lunchtime club</li><li>● Period 6 starting earlier to address clear gaps in knowledge</li><li>● Year 13 Tuesday intervention sessions</li><li>● MyTutor - 1 hour per week, for ten year 10 and ten year 7 students - 1 to 1</li></ul>
